



KNITTING PATTERN

KNITTED SLIPOVER IN WOOL AND MOHAIR



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YARN

Anna and Clara's 100% superwash wool yarn, 6 balls (each 50 g/70 m).

Anna and Clara's mohair yarn, 2 balls (each 25 g/215 m).

KNITTING NEEDLES

Circular knitting needle, size 7.0 mm

SIZE

One size

KNITTING GAUGE

In stocking stitch: 10 x 10 cm = 12 stitches x 18 rows.

HOW TO MAKE A KNITTED SLIPOVER IN WOOL AND MOHAIR

Knit the slipover using two strands of yarn, one strand of wool and one strand of mohair yarn.

Work back and forth on the needle.

BACK

Using circular knitting needle size 7.0 mm, cast on 60 stitches (sts). Work 10 rows (rs) of knit (k) 1, purl (p) 1 rib. Continue in stocking stitch. Work 60 rs. Now shape the armhole: In alternate rs, cast off 5-3-2-1-1 sts on both sides (36 sts). Continue in stocking stitch. Work 20 rs. Now shape the neckline: Cast off the centre 6 sts and work each side separately. Then, on alternate rs, cast off 3-2-1-1 sts at the neck edge (8 sts). Cast off. Work the other side to match, only reverse the shaping.

FRONT

Using circular knitting needle size 7.0 mm, cast on 60 sts. Work 10 rows of k1, p1 rib. Continue in stocking stitch. Work 60 rows. Now shape the armhole: cast off 5-3-2-1-1 sts in alternate rows on both sides (36 sts). Continue in stocking stitch. Work 10 rows. Cast off the centre 6 sts and work each side separately. Then, in alternate rows, cast off 3-1-1-1-1 sts at the neck edge (8 sts). Knit 12 rs of stocking stitch. Cast off. Work the other side to match, only reverse the shaping.

Sew side and shoulder seams together.

Weave in ends.

ARMHOLES

Using circular knitting needle size 7.0 mm, pick up 60 sts around the armholes. Work 8 rs of k1, p1 rib. Cast off.

NECKLINE

Using circular knitting needle size 7.0 mm, pick up 60 sts around the neckline. Work 8 rs of k1, p1 rib. Cast off.
