





KNITTING PATTERN

CUTE BABY HAT

It evokes a special kind of joy for the sisters when knitted creations find their way from yarn to child. With this pattern, you can knit a cute baby hat with twisted details that will bring warmth on chilly days.

YARN

Anna and Clara's wool bamboo yarn,
3 balls (each 50 g/125 m).

- Col 1: 1 ball.
- Col 2: 2 balls.

KNITTING NEEDLES

Double-pointed knitting needles size 4.0 mm.
Circular or straight knitting needles size 4.5 mm.
Cable needle, e.g. double-pointed knitting needle size 4.0 mm.

SIZE

6-12 months (1-2 years).

KNITTING GAUGE

In garter stitch:
10 x 10 cm = 22 stitches x 38 rows.

HOW TO KNIT A BABY HAT

Using double-pointed needles size 4.0 mm and Col 1, cast on 88 (96) stitches (sts). Work 2 rounds (rds) in k2, p2 rib.
Switch to Col 2 and continue working in rib until the work measures 10 (12) cm.
Switch to circular knitting needle size 4.5 mm.
Cast off 12 (16) sts of the rib. Now continue working back and forth as follows:

Row 1 (right side): 76 (80) k, cast on 6 sts. These 6 sts form the fold.

Row 2 (wrong side): p6, k1, p6, k62 (66), p6, k1, cast on 6 sts (fold).

Row 3: k88 (92).

Row 4: p6, k1, p6, k62 (66), p6, k1, p6.

Row 5: k7, slip 3 sts onto a cable needle in front of the work, k3, then k3 from the cable needle, k62 (66), slip 3 sts onto a cable needle in front of the work, k3, then k3 from the cable needle, k7.

Row 6: p6, k1, p6, k62 (66), p6, k1, p6.

Now repeat rows 3 to 6 until the hat measures 16 (18) cm from the start of the cable.

Cast off 12 sts on the right side (6 sts from the fold + 6 sts from the cable pattern). Then k to end.

Turn and cast off 6 sts at the beginning of each row 4 times in all, until 16 (21) sts remain. Cast off remaining sts.

FINISHING

Sew the fold firmly to the back along the back edge of the cable, which now forms the front edge of the hat.

Sew the hat together at the crown, and weave in ends.

Optional: Make a pompon in Col 1 and sew it to the top of the hat. The sisters recommend that you attach the pompon to the top of the hat very lightly with some sewing thread, so that it comes off easily if it gets caught in something.
