



KNITTING PATTERN

TRIANGULAR SCARF



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YARN

Anna and Clara's wool tweed yarn, 1 (2) 3 balls (each 50 g/100 m).

Alternatively, you can use:

Anna and Clara's wool bamboo yarn, 1 (2) 3 balls (each 50 g/125 m).

Anna and Clara's mohair nylon yarn, 1 (1) 2 balls (each 25 g/215 m).

KNITTING NEEDLES

Knitting needles, size 7.0 mm.

SIZES

Small: 82 x 32 cm

(Medium: 118 x 48 cm)

Large: 132 x 60 cm

INSTRUCTIONS

STEP 1

The scarf is knitted in linen stitch using knitting needles size 7 mm, 1 strand of Anna and Clara's wool tweed yarn or wool bamboo yarn and 1 strand of Anna and Clara's mohair nylon yarn. You increase 4 stitches in every second row.

STEP 2

Linen stitch: Cast on 5 stitches (sts).

Row 1 (Wrong Side, WS): Slip 1 stitch (sl1) purlwise, purl (p) 4.

Row 2 (Right Side, RS): sl1 knitwise, yarn over needle (yon), k1, yon, k1 (centre st), yarn over needle backwards (byo), k1, byo, k1.

Row 3: sl1 purlwise, p8.

Row 4: sl1 knitwise, yon, k1, bring the yarn forward (yfwd), sl1, k1, yon, k1 (centre st), byo, k1, yfwd, sl1, k1, byo, k1.

Row 5: sl1 purlwise, p12.

Row 6: sl1 knitwise, yon, k1, yfwd, sl1, k1, yfwd, sl1, k1, yon, k1 (centre st), byo, k1, yfwd, sl1, k1, yfwd, sl1, k1, byo, k1.

STEP 3

Continue, repeating rows 5 and 6 all the time. The number of stitches increases by 4 in each knit row. Work until the scarf is the desired size.

STEP 4

To prevent the edge from rolling, work a triple cast off as follows:

Begin casting off from the RS. k1, then, from the purl side, use the right needle to transfer the 3rd stitch loop below to the left needle. Knit this st together with the next st on the left needle, lift st on right needle over this st. Continue in the same way until all sts are cast off.

Weave in ends and press your scarf.



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
